

HELENSVILLE A&P ASSOCIATION RURAL SCHOLARSHIP – Application 2018

This is a scholarship for a Candidate with interest in pursuing a career in New Zealand's Primary Industries sector. It includes related studies such as agriculture, horticulture, veterinary, bee keeping, aqua farming, viticulture etc. The course of study **must** be full-time for at least **one year**, physically attending the institution.

Preference will be given to applicants who have contributed to our local A & P Show.

1. The application form must be accompanied by the following:

- a)** Application form with contact details, including a copy of resident status.
- b)** Please attach a written presentation that outlines your present involvement and future aspirations with the New Zealand Primary Industries Sector (maximum 1 page).
- c)** A testimonial or reference from your school, tertiary provider or current employer supporting your application, or from a local resident (not an Executive member of the Helensville A & P Association).
- d)** Proof of enrolment at an approved Polytechnic/ University or Primary Industry related course.

2. Your application will be assessed on:

- a)** How your area of study contributes to NZ Primary Industry, with particular regard to the benefits for the New Zealand rural community.
- b)** Your knowledge of New Zealand's Primary Industry.

c) Your future career prospects in New Zealand's rural sector.

3. One Scholarship Award offered to the value of \$500 for a 1 (one) year tenure.

4. Closing dates for applications: 30 September 2018.

6. Payment of the Helensville A&P Association Rural Scholarship will be made to the successful applicant by 31st October 2018, on proof of enrolment in the indicated field of study.

7. Decision makers: Helensville A & P Association Executive Committee Members 2018/2019.

8. Helensville A&P Association must be advised immediately if the successful applicant withdraws from the course before completing the academic year, as a proportional refund will be expected.
